



# CRAZYLEGS PARTICIPANT GUIDE



## WHEELCHAIR START TIME: 9:50 AM RUNNERS START TIME: 10:00 AM

Start on State Street at the intersection of N. Lake Street.

Line up on Library Mall with staging towards Park Street in front of the walkers. Runners will line up according to pace signage posted in the staging area.

With the start and finish line in close proximity to each other - there is not a sweat truck or gear check option.

A group of runners will be released every 30 to 45 seconds. Line up where you feel most comfortable.

No pets, bikes, strollers, baby joggers, wagons or other accessors are allowed within the run.

### SHOW OFF YOUR SMILE ON COURSE!

Professional photographers from Focal Flame will be on course and at the finish line capturing FREE digital photos that you will be able to download post-event.

To ensure you are able to access all photos taken of you during the event, clearly pin your race bib to the front of your clothing or shorts for photo identification.

## WALKERS START TIME: 10:20 AM

Start on State Street at the intersection of N. Lake Street.

Stage on Library Mall near Park Street lining up behind the runners. Walks will organize in order of Speed Walkers, Casual Walkers, and Walkers with Accessories, to include all strollers, wagons, and baby joggers.

No pets or bikes are permitted on the walk course.

## NEW FOR 2024!

Due to construction at Camp Randall Stadium, the Crazylegs Classic run and walk will finish outside the Kohl Center.

With the start and finish line in close proximity to each other - there is not a sweat truck or gear check option.

All participants and spectators will pass through a walk-through metal detector when entering the Kohl Center for the post-race party. Strollers will not be permitted inside the Kohl Center and will need to be parked outside. Backpacks and large bags are prohibited inside the building. All participants 21 years of age or older have a wristband on their bib. You must wear this wristband in-order to receive alcoholic beverages at the post-race party. Participants that appear 40 years of age or younger must also produce a valid photo ID at beverage distribution locations inside the Kohl Center.

## PARKING INFORMATION:

Friday: Parking will be available at meters, and as space permits in UW-Madison parking ramps 29, 46 and 83. Note that surface lots near the Kohl Center are reserved for campus permit holders, individuals parking without a permit are subject to \$50 parking violations.

Saturday: Parking will be sold in UW-Madison Lots 46, 83, and 91 near the start and finish line outside the Kohl Center for \$10. Credit card payment is required. Lots open at 7 AM.

## RULES AND SAFETY REQUESTS:

- Strollers, wagons, and baby joggers are not allowed in the run.
- Obey race marshals and yield to emergency vehicles.
- For the safety of all—no pets are allowed on the run or walk course. Service dogs with proper identification will be allowed.
- Any run participant on the course after the NOON closure will need to move to the sidewalk, as all streets and intersections will re-open at that time.
- Walkers need to follow all traffic signals at intersections.
- Be respectful for other participants around you at the finish line and continue moving for your safety and the safety of others behind you.

## MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

In case of an emergency, contact the nearest police officer or course marshal. Madison Fire Department paramedics will be riding on UTV's throughout the course and available to quickly assist. A First Aid Room will be available inside the Kohl Center (Section 118).

## CRAZYLEGS POST RACE PARTY:

Everyone is invited to stay for entertainment by Rod Tuff Curls and the Bench Press inside the Kohl Center. Participants and their guests are both invited to take advantage of live music, free photos stations, sponsor displays.

Participants receive 2 complimentary refreshments via the tear off on their bib. Options include beer, seltzers, Pepsi, and Gatorade.

## ALCOHOL MANAGEMENT POLICY:

Crazylegs participants are required to wear the wristband off their bib to indicate they are 21 and older at the post-race party. **Participants that appear 40 years of age or younger must produce a valid photo ID at each beer stand.**
